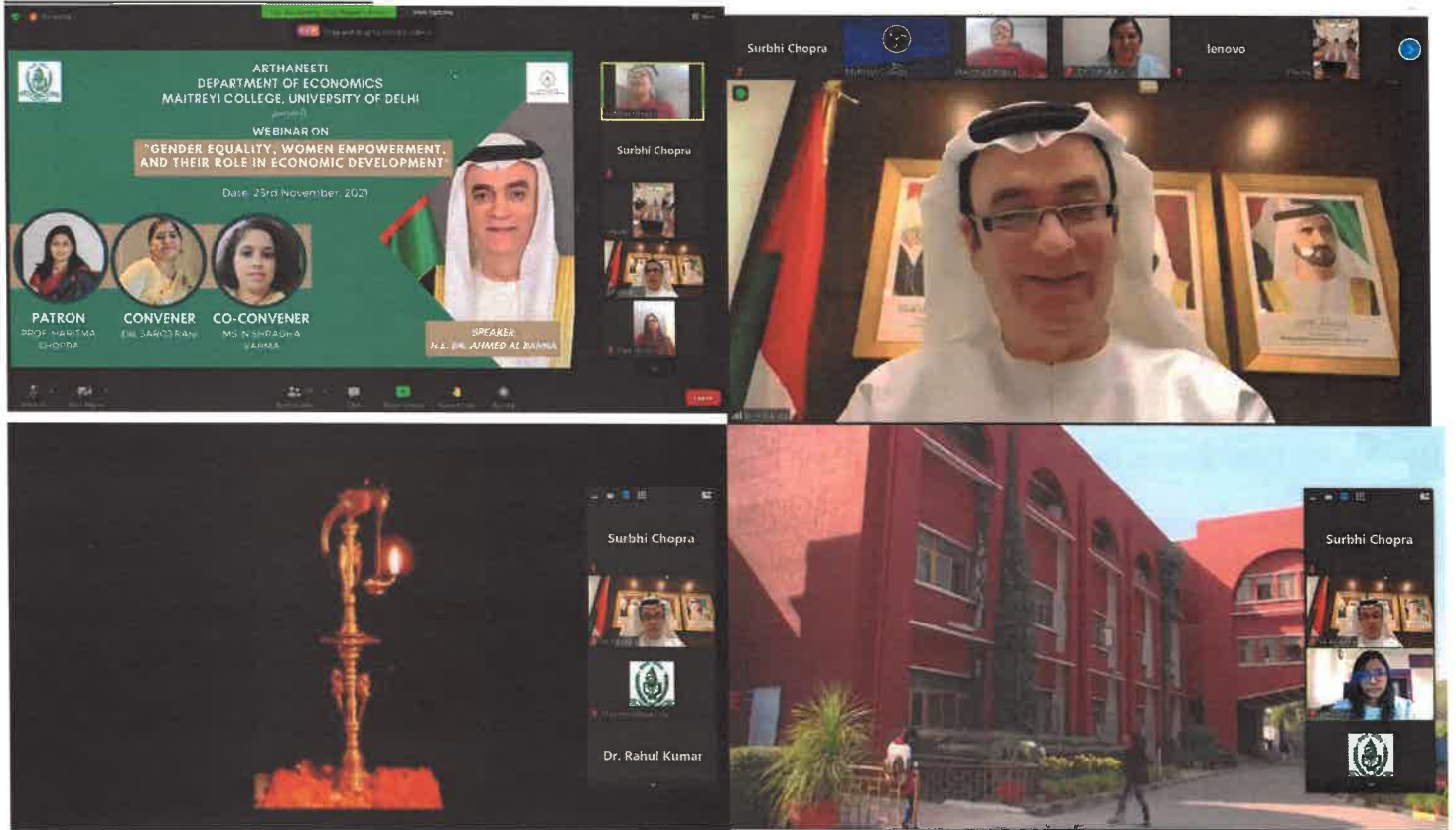

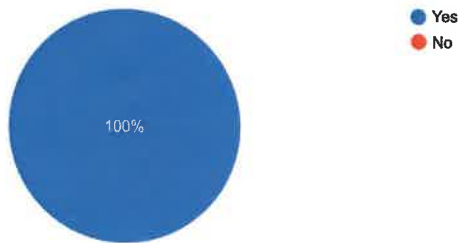

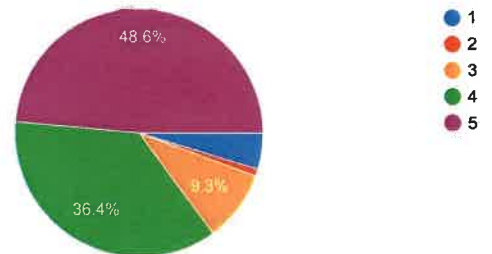

The webinar commenced with a warm welcome of the speaker, Dr.Mrinalini Jha. The speaker began with the introduction regarding the research aspects on the "Impact of Covid-19 pandemic on indicators of economic well-being" step-by-step.

The session can be summed up by suggesting that the impact on the urban sector was worse during the first wave, the recovery of the economy to the pre-pandemic income levels was incomplete till May '21, there was a massive rise in the inequality in the first wave which extended more during the second wave, we saw a prolonged effect on indebtedness for lower deciles and on the income and employment for richer deciles. After this a doubt session was held in which all the queries of students regarding the topic were answered by the speaker.

The webinar experienced an active participation from the students of Maitreyi College. The students exhibited a keen interest in the topic and displayed their own thoughts. The session ended with a token of appreciation by a student for the Speaker and the members present in the webinar. The session was concluded with a vote of thanks by the moderator.

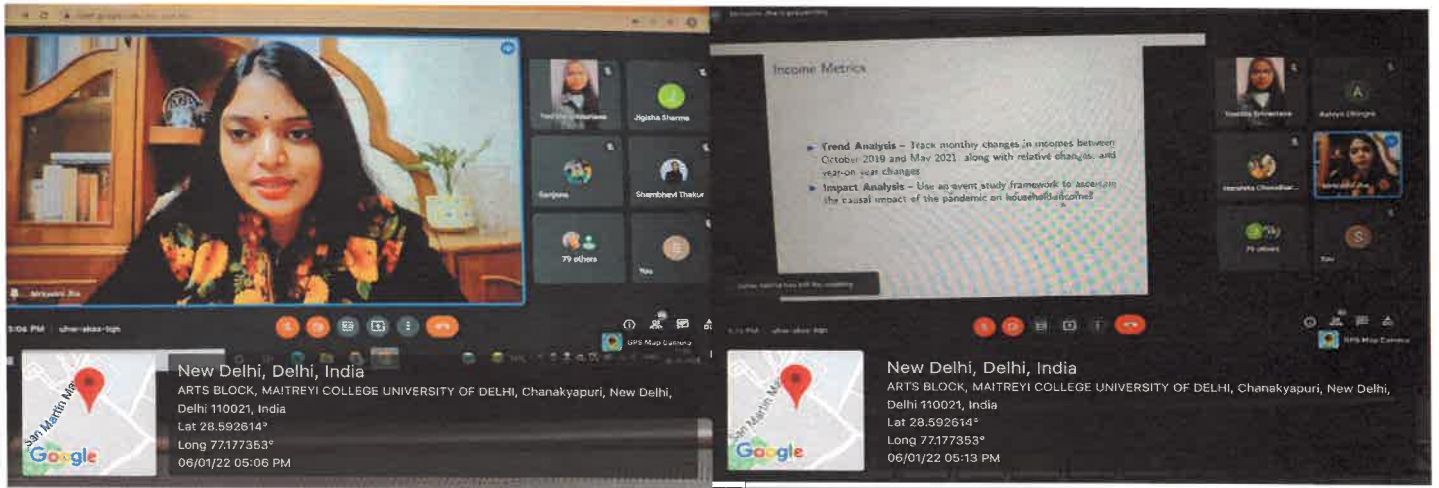

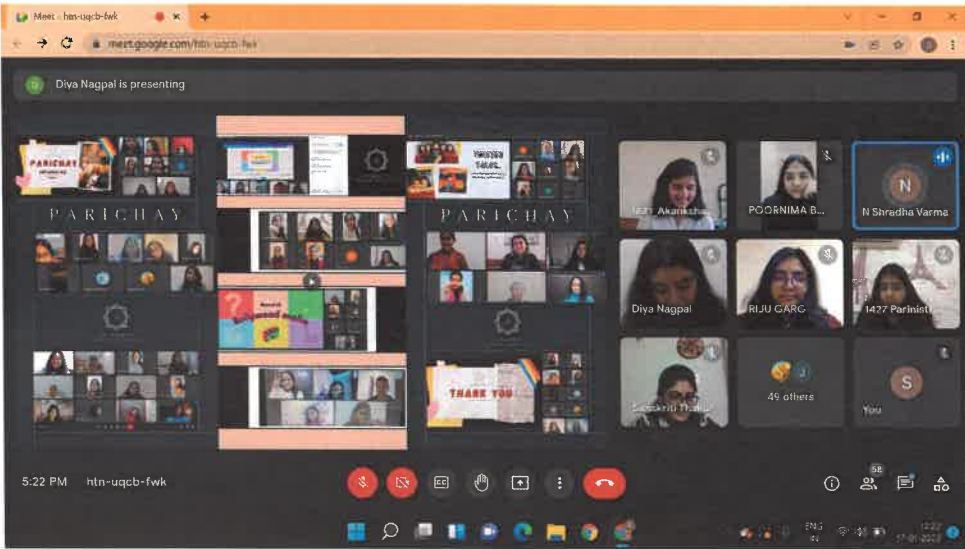

## DECODING BUDGET '22

University Webinar

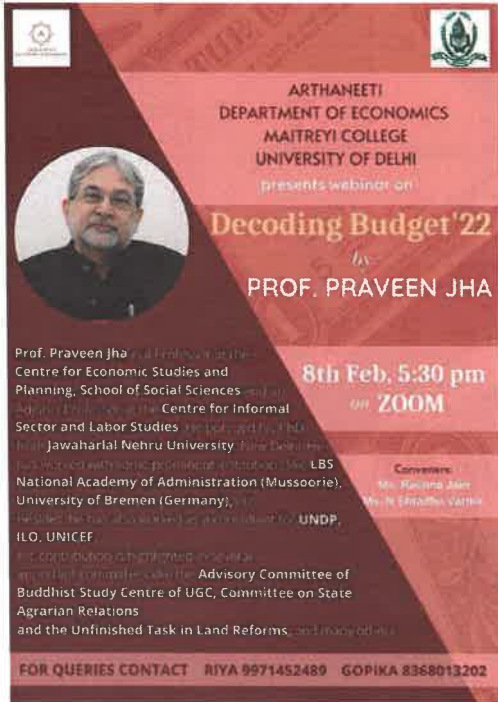
The webinar commenced with the basic definition and the need of budget. The first aspect mentioned was that despite the pandemic situation, the receipts of the government have increased in comparison to the previous year by 2 lakh crores. The second aspect highlighted the 25% increase in capital expenditure, which would create a positive synergy by generating employment and improving infrastructure. The speaker appreciated the drastic improvement in Direct and Indirect tax collection figures.

Another important issue highlighted was the "Cess and Surcharge Issue" where the funds, going to the states through collection, were not satisfactory. In monetary value, this shortfall was estimated to be 3 lakh crores. The trends in the expenditure on budget as a percentage of GDP were mentioned, where the current year estimate stood at 16.2%. The speaker then pointed out two ways to handle fiscal chaos - one by focusing on resource mobilisation and the other to compress expenditure. The speaker noted that the actual available capital expenditure is much less than the figures. A significant downfall was witnessed in subsidies for fertilizers, pesticides, and food. The budget for midday meal was found to be compressed.

The speaker threw light upon the K Shaped recovery that post-covid India and concluded that the whole picture is quite ambiguous. The webinar concluded after a query session.

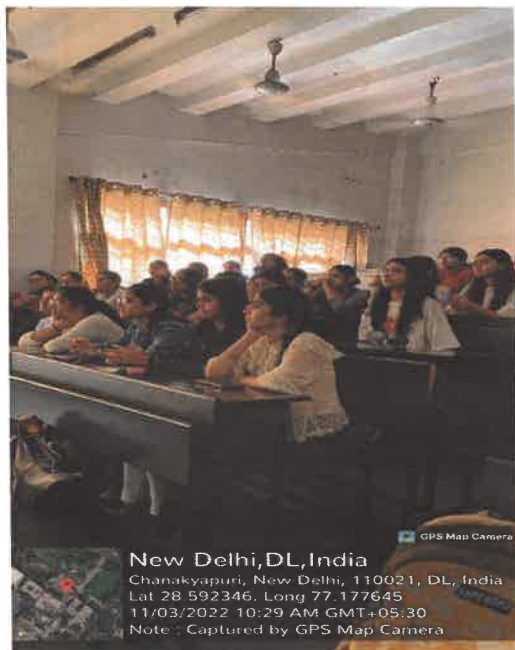
